



- Mr. Mukunda Madhav Gogoi and Dr. Deborshee Gogoi for their excellence and expertise towards art and craft. They would serve the dramatics society as Art Directors.
- Mr. Pradip Dutta, Dr. Subhadeep Chakraborty and Mr. Suraj Hajong for their fine sense of knowledge on music. They would serve the dramatics society as Music Directors.

OBJECTIVES OF THE SOCIETY:

- 1. To revive the lost glory of drama and theatre in Digboi College.
- To imbibe the students with an interest for theatre as a collaborative form of performing art.
- 3. To boost the cultural environment in the college campus.
- To identify the talented students in the field of theatre and provide them a platform for it.
- 5. To provide a platform for students to develop and nurture essential life skills.
- To conduct theatre workshops at frequent intervals for the holistic growth of the students in the field of theatre.
- To encourage the students to participate in different competitions and represent Digboi College.
- To conduct shows at different parts of the country and represent Digboi College.

ACTION PLAN:

- Start a six-monthly certificate course and a one year diploma course in acting and dramatics by initiating a Centre for Performing Arts in Digboi College.
- 2. Conduct an audition in the Auditorium for identifying the raw talents of Digboi College in the field of theatre. A compulsory notice is advised to be served at every department whereby a minimum of 4 students should be sent for the auditions. There should, however, be no maximum limit for the number of students per department. The departments may conduct internal auditions, if required or may straightaway propose the names.
- 3. The final audition shall involve a mono-act of 3 minutes to which the students shall perform. The language should either be Assamese, Hindi or English. From the final auditions, the dramatics society for the session shall be selected by the core committee members. The society shall hold such an audition every year for bringing in the new talents in the group.
- A student in-charge shall be elected by the student group members. He/ She shall be in-charge of the decorum of the society and student representative to external agencies.
- Subsequently, a workshop shall be organized to train the students from the basic level.
- There shall be weekly meetings at the auditorium after college hours where rehearsals and training shall take place.
- Subsequently, a one-act drama show shall be organized in the college auditorium with the presence of teachers and students.
- 8. Shows shall not be free for anyone. Flexible Ticket Pricing Technique is to be applied for developing the sense of respect for theatre and its artists. There shall be a box at every entry of the auditorium to which any amount as desired by the audience shall be paid. This is done to imbibe the thought that drama is a costly process and culture is something that we need to pay for.
- 9. Prepare a minimum of five stage plays for college week.
- 10. Prepare a team for youth festival.
- 11. Conduct street plays across the district with media coverage for publicity.
- 12. Participate in different competitions across the state and country.




